英教育部停止资助 5000 门 GCSE 考试后学习的资质课程

在英格兰,5000 多门很少或根本无人就读的资质课程被取消。在 12000 门可供 16 岁以上学生选择的资质课程当中,英国教育部停止资助约 40%的课程,并计划在 9 月份推出新的 T-level 课程(英国学生在完成 GCSE 考试后可选择的职业技术类课程)。

This will reduce by half the number of **qualifications on offer** for 16 to 19-year-olds. Some courses, due to lose their funding, have fallen out of use, others attract small numbers. They include some BTecs, City & Guilds, NVQs, and diplomas.

精简课程的这一举措将减少 16 至 19 岁学生可选择的资质课程数量的一半。一些将失去资助的课程已无人就读,还有的课程只吸引少数人学习。这包含英国商业与技术教育委员会提供的资格证书(BTecs)、英国伦敦城市行业协会发放的职业证书(City & Guilds)、英国国家职业资格证书(NVQs)及其它文凭。

Ministers want to shift gradually to three main options for 16-year-olds to choose from - **apprenticeships**, A-levels, and the new T-levels. Each T-level will be **equivalent** to three A-levels and will include **work-based** learning.

英国教育部大臣们希望把目前的考试制度逐步精简为三个主要课程种类,供 16 岁学生选择:学徒制、A-level 课程(相当于英国大学入学考试)和新 T-level 课程。每门 T-level 课程将等同于三门 A-level 课程,而且会包含以工作为基础的学习。

The first students will **enrol on** three new T-levels this autumn, with fewer than 2,000 **places** available. Tom Bewick from the Federation of Awarding Bodies said care needed to be taken with **pruning away** qualifications before the new system is fully established.
